

Doughnut Instructions



- Cut a thick wiggly line around the hole in your colored paper to make frosting.
- Glue the frosting on your doughnut.
- Glue "sprinkles" onto your frosting.

Parent Tip:

This craft uses a lot of fine motor skills: Cutting and picking up and gluing the sprinkles. It's important to start working with children on building their fine motor skills early on in life. Fine motor skills help children perform important tasks like feeding themselves, grasping toys, buttoning and zipping clothes, writing, drawing, and more. The ability to complete self-care and every day tasks helps a child's self esteem and confidence to increase. Doing fun activities like crafts help build your child's fine motor skills in a fun, engaging way.
