

Menorah Instructions



- Trace your hands on the blue piece of paper and cut them out.
- Glue your hand cut outs to the white piece of paper. Make sure your thumbs are overlapping.
- Rip off small pieces of yellow tissue paper, crinkle them up, and glue them at the top of each finger for the candle flame.
- Decorate your menorah by writing Happy Hanukkah and/or drawing a Star of David.

Parent Tip:

Menorah: A nine-branched candelabra lit during the eight-day holiday of Hanukkah. On each night of Hanukkah, a new branch is lit. The ninth candle, the shamash ("helper"), is used to light all the other candles.

Star of David: A generally recognized symbol of the Jewish Community and Judaism.

Hanukkah is from December 10-December 18 this year.
