- Color the front and back of your tree with markers.
- Glue googly eyes on the tree.
- Draw a smiley face with a marker.
- Glue buttons on the tree for ornaments.
- Glue the puff ball to the top of your tree.
- String the ribbon through the hole and tie it to make a loop.
- Hang the happy tree in your house to spread Christmas cheer!

Parent Tip:

This project involves a lot of fine motor skills. Fine motor skills are movements such as pinching or grasping. These types of movements are important for young children to practice as they develop because they help children lay the foundation to do everyday tasks such as buttoning a shirt, tying shoe laces, grasping a pencil, using utensils, typing on a keyboard and much more.
