

Sledding Hill Instructions



- Color the sledding hill and sledders with a crayon
- Tape the popsicle stick to the back of the sledders.
- Place the popsicle stick in the slit on the sledding hill and move you sledders up and down the hill.

Parent Tip:

This craft presents a great opportunity for you to talk to your child. Ask them about the last time you went sledding. How did they feel? Excited, nervous, scared, happy? Did they feel different after going down the hill?

Ask your child to make up a story about the sledders in the craft. Where are they sledding? Are they siblings or friends? What are they going to do after they go sledding? Making up stories with your kids is lots of fun and also stimulates their memory, increases vocabulary, promotes values and knowledge of traditions, stimulates their speaking abilities, and increases their self-esteem and confidence.
