

Dragon Puppet Instructions



- Color the dragon pieces with marker (the head and tail will be folded in half so your dragon puppet looks good on both sides)
- Fold the red paper like an accordion.
- Fold the head and tail in half and glue them to the front and back of the red paper.
- Cut thin strips of the tissue paper and glue it to the dragons mouth.
- Glue a popsicle stick to the front and back of the dragon. Glue a leg on each side of each popsicle stick.
- Hold one popsicle stick in each hand and move the dragon around.

Parent Tip:

Dragons are a symbol of China's culture that represent good luck, a long life, and wisdom. Performing the dragon dance during festivals and celebrations is believed to drive away evil spirits and usher in good luck and blessings for the community.
