

Night Sky Instructions



- Find a bowl or something else round to trace.
- Put the bowl on top of the tin foil and trace around it.
- Cut out the circle.
- Crinkle the circle of foil into a ball.
- Carefully open the ball and flatten it out.
- Glue the foil onto the black piece of paper.
- Stick the star stickers around the moon.

Parent Tip:

Let your child explore the foil texture while creating the moon. Aluminum foil is such a unique material for sensory exploration. Its crinkly sound, shiny appearance, and bumpy texture will pique their curiosity.

Talk about how the aluminum foil looks like the surface of the moon. The bumpy foil texture is a great representation of the craters, while the shiny appearance demonstrates how the light from the sun reflects off the moon.
