

# Chick in the Mud Instructions



- Color your chick with markers.
- Rip off small pieces of the yellow tissue paper and crinkle into little balls.
- Glue the tissue paper balls to the chicks belly.
- Rip off small pieces of the brown tissue paper.
- Crinkle the pieces and then glue them under the chick and covering the chick's feet.

## Parent Tip:

Ripping and crinkling paper are tons of fun for kids, but are also great for your child's development. Ripping and crinkling paper helps develop fine motor skills, especially focusing on grip strength. It also teaches cause and effect, and is a precursor to using scissors.
