

# Lilly Pad Instructions



- Color or paint the paper plate blue.
- Turn the green baking cup inside out. Cut slits in the wavy part of the baking cup.
- Glue the round part of the green baking cup to the middle of the paper plate.
- Glue the bottom of the pink baking cup on top of the green baking cup.
- Crinkle the tissue paper into a ball and glue it in the center of the pink baking cup.

## Parent Tip:

Talk to your child about the types of animals you might find in ponds and around lily pads (turtles, dragonflies, beetles, frogs). Did you know that frogs often use lily pads to hide from predators? Also, in the heat of the summer, lily pads provide shade to keep fish cool.
