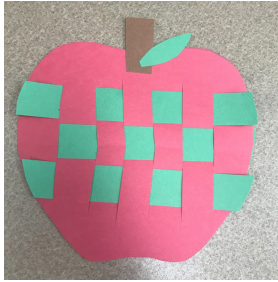


Apple Instructions



- Take one of the green strips and weave it through the slits in the apple (under, over, under, over, etc.) until you get to the end.
- Take a second green strip and weave it through the opposite way (over, under, over, under, etc.)
- Weave the third strip the same way as the first.
- Cut off the excess green paper.
- Cut a leaf out of the excess green paper. Glue the stem and leaf to the top of your apple.

Parent Tip:

Weaving helps develop your child's fine motor skills.

Weaving also helps with, eye-hand coordination and concentration, problem-solving skills. understanding of patterns and sequencing, and language skills such as naming colors, and language concepts such as 'in,' 'out,' 'up,' 'down' etc.
